& tax withholding

- W-2s are available by January 31 each year. Opt for online access
 to receive your W-2 sooner than waiting for a hard copy. Visit
 Employee Self-Service (ESS) and click on My W-2s to authorize
 web delivery.
- 2. Taxable wages are not equal to annual salary.*
- 3. Taxable wages are the same for both state and federal tax returns.
- 4. Keeping your address up to date ensures that your state and local tax withholding is accurate.**
- 5. You adjust the amount of income taxes being withheld by visiting ESS and clicking on the My W-4 link under the blue My Taxes banner. Log in using your MPCS username and password and follow the on-screen instructions.
- 6. Deductions, such as those for the charity campaign, do not appear on your W-2.***

^{*} Taxable wages are based on calendar year and do not include pretax benefits (e.g., health insurance, pension contributions, and tax-deferred annuities).

^{**} Check the latest ePaystub to see if your address is correct. If it is not, visit Employee Self-Service and click on **My address change** under the orange My Information banner.
