

Montgomery County Public Schools (MCPS) is beginning the Schematic Design Phase for an approved capital project in your neighborhood.

This notice is to inform you of the Schematic Design community works session scheduled for the reopening of Charles W. Woodward High School. MCPS extends an invitation to you to participate in this process. While all are invited, the community is encouraged to send representatives from their respective streets, areas, and associations. The presentation material will be the same from the school community work session scheduled 9 days prior to this work session, but this work session is for the adjacent neighbors and communities. Everyone present will have the opportunity to hear about the proposed project.

The purpose of the work session is to surface and discuss ideas in the development of a preliminary design to determine spatial relationships within the site, the pedestrian and traffic flow of the site and how the project will impact the community at large.

Participants will include representatives of the Home Owners Associations, neighbors, government agencies, the design architects, and staff from MCPS Division of Construction and Division of Capital Planning.

The date and time for the work session is shown below. The work session is scheduled in the evening to allow for maximum community involvement.
