This plant generates its power from burning coal, as is the case in over 60% of the power plants in the US. The process over 5,000 tons of coal per day, which comes in via CSX rail-car. They perform tours of the plant for groups up to 35 at a time.

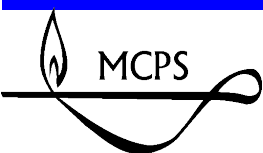
