



FREE Screenings for Children Ages 3 to 5 Years

Do you suspect that your child's development may be delayed and may need special help BEFORE BEGINNING SCHOOL?

LOOK FOR THESE EARLY WARNING SIGNS

- Seems to have difficulty seeing or hearing**
- Has difficulty following simple directions**
- Has difficulty naming objects and people**
- Cannot be understood when speaking**
- Compared to others of own age, has difficulty walking, hopping, throwing, or feeding themselves**
- Learns slower than children the same age**

If you have concerns about your child, call the Child Find Office. Child Find provides **FREE SCREENINGS** for children (ages 3 to 5 years) in the developmental areas of speech, motor, and cognition. Vision and hearing screenings are also available. **Clinics are held at 4511 Bestor Drive, Rockville, Maryland 20853.**

In order to complete the Child Find process for children who are 5 years of age, the screening questionnaire must be received in the Child Find office by **mid-March** of the year that your child will be eligible for kindergarten.

After **mid-March**, parents should contact their elementary school to share concerns.
