







Sick Kids: When to Stay Home from School

Fever	Diarrhea or Vomiting	Cough that won't Stop	Rash	Head Lice	Eye Infection
					
<p>A temperature of 100.4 or higher</p>	<p>Within the past 24 hours</p>	<p>Or other problems with breathing</p>	<p>Body rash with itching and/or fever</p>	<p>Itchy head, active head lice</p>	<p>Eye is red and oozing a yellow or green discharge</p>
When to Return to School					
<p>Fever free for 24 hours without the use of fever reducing medication such as ibuprofen or acetaminophen</p>	<p>Free from diarrhea and/or vomiting for at least 24 hours and evaluated by a provider if needed</p>	<p>Cough is mild and infrequent and evaluated by a provider if needed</p>	<p>Free from rash, itching or fever and evaluated by a provider if needed</p>	<p>After first head lice treatment</p>	<p>24 hours after starting antibiotic eye drops or ointment</p>
