



Chromebook Behavior Do's and Don'ts



Do:

- Close the lid when walking with the Chromebook
- Check for pens and pencils before closing the lid
- Only use your assigned Chromebook
- Report problems to your teacher immediately
- Only go to assigned, approved websites
- Shut down your Chromebook every afternoon and connect to the charger in the cart

Don't:

- Write on or scratch any part of the Chromebook
- Put stickers on the Chromebook
- Remove keys or the trackpad
- Eat or drink near a Chromebook

Consequences

Loss of Chromebook Privileges

You or your family will have to pay for Chromebook damage

- Missing keys, trackpad peeled up, minor damage to case, broken camera, broken charger: **\$25**
- Moderate case damage: **\$50**
- Damaged screen, major case damage: **\$150**
- Replacement due to fluid damage, destruction, loss: **\$300**
