



Are you interested in becoming a Safety Patrol?

The job of being a patrol is not easy. It requires a great deal of commitment. Below are areas that you will be evaluated on by the Safety Patrol Committee. First, you must be in 5th grade for the upcoming school year. Then, you must exhibit these qualities and abide by the patrol expectations throughout the school year:

- You complete classwork/homework on time.

- You respect others.
- You are fair.
- You are safety conscious.
- You are a good problem solver.
- You demonstrate good leadership skills.

The primary job of Safety Patrols is to help students cross streets safely; to be safe pedestrians and bus riders; and to foster qualities of leadership and good citizenship in the patrol members. Being a Cedar Grove Safety Patrol is an honor because you are a model for our community, not just for the other students in our school. You represent our school every day, no matter where you are or what you are doing.

Patrols are expected to:

- Look, act and be alert.
- Report for duty on time.
- Always set a good example. Know and practice safe walking rules.
- Never stop vehicles.
- Perform patrol duties faithfully.
- Be neat and clean while on duty.
- Be dependable and trustworthy.
- Be courteous and polite at all times.
- Treat others as you would like to be treated.
- Wear the patrol belt and badge proudly.
- Remind classmates of safe walking rules without being bossy.
- Give correct crossing signals to classmates.
- Obey rules of the patrol, school, and home.

If you are selected as a patrol, you must abide by these standards and expectations. Failure to do so will result in being removed from being a patrol.
