#### English Language Arts

In reading this month...

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#### Math

In math this month...

We will work on Module 6. Students will work on comparative word problem types. While students have already solved some comparative problem types, this is their first opportunity to name these types of problems and learn to represent comparisons using tape diagrams with two tapes. Students will also extend their understanding of tens and ones of numbers up to 100. For example, they will mentally find 10 more, 10 less, 1 more, and 1 less and compare numbers using the symbols >, =, and <.

#### **Science and Social Studies**

In science this marking period...

Students will observe plant structures, and relate their features to their function. Students will also connect changes in daylength to plant structures. Additionally, students will observe the features of bean seeds, and construct an explanation of their function by planting seeds and observing their growth.

In social studies this marking period...


