Patriot Success

The staff at GES is focused on working with students to promote positive behavior in all school settings. We have three school rules which are reinforced daily.

Be Respectful! Be Responsible! Be Safe!

Students who are following the school rules in the various locations of the school can earn PATRIOT PENNIES.

Pennies are given by staff to students in order to acknowledge their positive behaviors. Once received, the pennies go into individual baggies/envelopes in the classrooms. Students will accumulate their pennies in order to attend monthly grade level events.

When school rules are followed, students have an opportunity to be recognized for their efforts by receiving a Patriot Penny! When school rules are not followed, specific consequences result based on the behavior as determined by their classroom teacher.
