

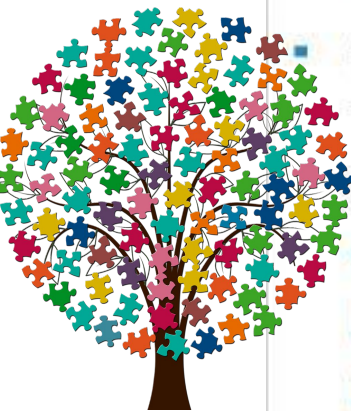

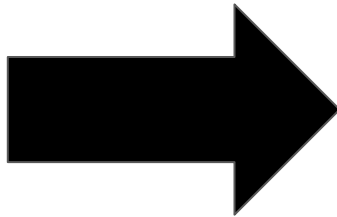

How Do Schools Qualify to Receive Title I Funds? ¿Cómo califican las escuelas para recibir fondos del Título I?

- Each year families complete a FARMS application in order to receive free and reduced-price meals based on family income level.
- This form is available online and will also be available in print at schools.
- You may fill out the paper application OR the online application. NOT both.
- Cada año, las familias completan una solicitud de FARMS para recibir comidas gratuitas o de precio reducido según el nivel de ingresos familiares
- Este formulario está disponible en línea y también se enviará a casa.
- Puede completar la solicitud en papel O la solicitud en línea. No ambos.



Then... Luego...

- ❖ The school returns all FARMS applications to the Division of Food and Nutrition Services (MCPS) before or by the end of October.
- ❖ Schools who have the highest percentages of students receiving Free and Reduced-price Meals services will qualify to receive Title I federal funds the following school year.

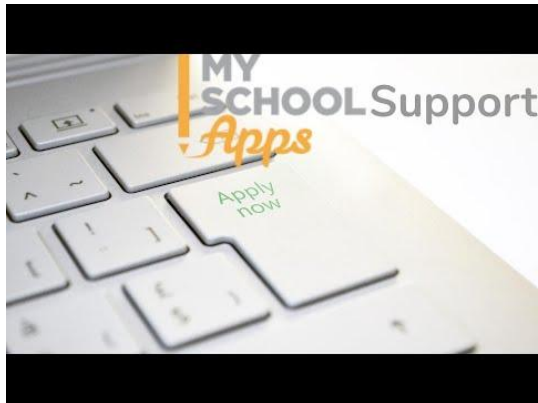

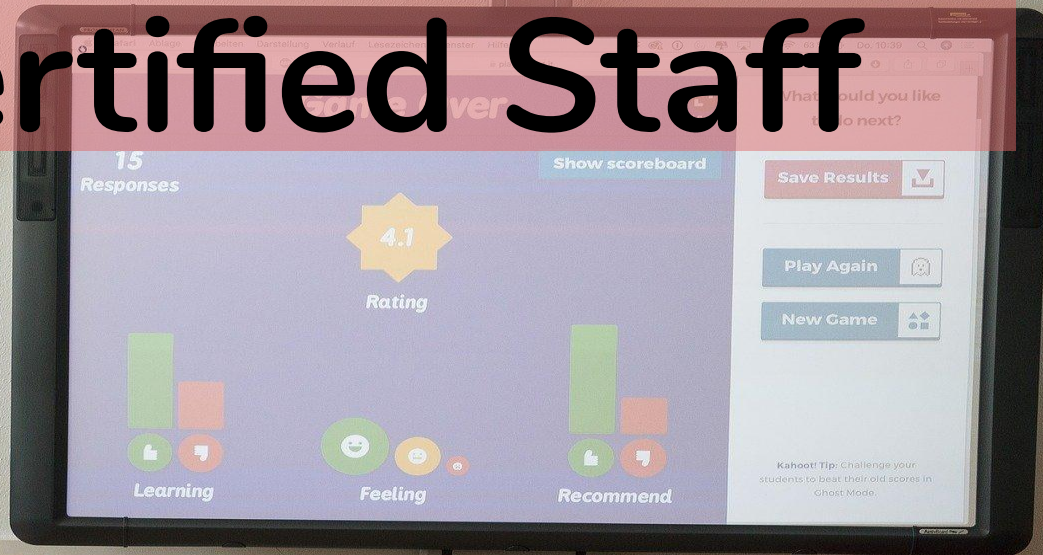

Our Beliefs

- Montgomery County Public Schools (MCPS) Title I believes that when schools and families work together, children achieve.
- Montgomery County Public Schools (MCPS) practices that create a culture of mutual respect and support the involvement of our children is a shared responsibility. We believe that when parents are involved, students will be more successful.
- The school system, as well as individual schools, make the commitment to establish programs and practices that support parent involvement.
- All MCPS staff members in Title I schools are expected to convey a commitment to parents in the education of the school system.
- Information will be provided to parents in their language of the school system.
- Parents of English Language Learners and children with disabilities will be included in participation efforts.
- This plan has been developed jointly with parents and is aligned with Board of Education Policy ABC- Strategic Plan.
- In this plan, "parent" is intended to include parents, guardians, and other family members involved in supervising the child's schooling.

Our Process

- The Title I District Level Parent and Family Engagement Plan is jointly developed by the Title I Parent Advisory Committee (PAC), which is made up of Title I staff and parents of students attending Title I schools.
- The plan provides information as to how the Title I requirements will be carried out at the district level.
- Parent workshops, parent meetings, and other events are opportunities for families to provide feedback using the Evaluation Tool.
- The feedback from the Evaluation Tool is analyzed annually at the Winter (PAC) meeting.
- Suggestions are provided to revise the plan and create opportunities for increased parent engagement.
- A school-level template that includes the same requirements is used to create a School Level Parent and Family Engagement Plan at each Title I school.
- Schools analyze and make revisions to their School Level Parent and Family Engagement Plan.
- The District-Level Plan is distributed to all Parent Engagement committee meetings and leadership at each Title I school annually at their Parent meetings.
- The District-Level Plan is distributed to families in a variety of ways, including newsletters, electronic communication, and Family meetings/workshops.

Communications, such as newsletters, invitations, flyers, etc., will be available in the "major" languages of MCPS including, but not limited to, Spanish, Korean, Chinese, Vietnamese, French, and Arabic.
