## Costume Day at Rockwell ES

On Friday, October 29, 2021, we will have "costume day" at Rockwell and we invite your child to plan to wear a costume for Fall/Halloween celebration with his/her class. It is completely optional to dress up on this day! For the last hour of the day,

classes will celebrate with special activities like crafts, games, and other social activities. Unlike traditional years, we will not be having a community parade nor class parties with food and parents in attendance. We are limiting this celebration to "in-school" staff and students only in an effort to keep within our health and safety guidance for congregating people in the building. Your child can come to school wearing his/her costume as long as it does not interfere with their movement and/or ability to participate in all aspects of their school day. If you prefer, your child may bring a costume to change into at the end of the day for the activities as long as this can be done independently and in their classroom (i.e. over their regular clothing). Below are some do's and don'ts

with regards to costumes to help you plan with your child.

Yes, this will work! No, this is not allowed! Dress up as a favorite book, television, or Dressing in scary or bloody costumes or movie character masks Dress up as a favorite profession or career Wearing masks of any kind (all students and (i.e. teacher, nurse, firefighter, police officer, staff are required to wear regular professional athlete, pilot, hair stylist) health-related masks, so no other face coverings are permitted) Dress up as your favorite animal Bringing or planning to carry any costume props (swords, weapons, etc.) Dress up as any appropriate seasonal or Dressing in any blow-up costume or one that holiday character prevents a student from properly sitting in their seat for class
