

ParentVue Accounts

If you need any support activating your ParentVue account, please reach out to Patti Polsinelli (<u>patricia_bray@mcpsmd.org</u>). This will enable you to receive important communication from the school, to view your child's grades, and to see important documents throughout the year such as MAP testing results, interim reports, and report cards!

Fall MAP Testing

The window for MAP testing is open through October 6! MAP (Measures of Academic Progress) is a reading and math assessment students take three times a year to measure growth. Students in Grades K-2 will take MAP-P (the primary math test). Students in Grades 3-5 will take MAP-R (the reading test) and MAP-M (the math test). Both tests are completed on the chromebook at school and are used to measure your child's instructional level, in order to guide instruction and measure growth. Interested in learning more about MAP testing? Here is a presentation we created a few years ago! Your child's teacher will share with you the test dates, but please reach out to Patti Polsinelli (patricia_bray@mcpsmd.org) if you have any general testing questions!
