Free and Reduced Meals - We are reaching out to make sure that every Twinbrook Family has had an opportunity to fill out the on-line free meal form. Do you need help filling out the form? You can stop by the office or call us at 240-740-3450 and a staff member will assist you with this process. These benefits help you as well as providing benefits for all the students at school. When we qualify for Title I, Twinbrook receives extra funding to hire more teachers. This enables us to provide smaller class sizes. The extra funding also provides reading support, math support, extra materials and other assistance. Thank you for your continued support for our Twinbrook Family. MEALS Important Changes this year - There is a major change in the cafeteria this year! Students who do not qualify for free/reduced meals will have to pay for their lunch. This is a major change as breakfast and lunches were free for all students for the past two years. (All breakfast will remain free this year). MCPS cafeterias utilize a computerized Point of Sale (POS) system. Students utilize an ID Card with a specialized barcode at mealtime. A student's Free and Reduced Meal (FARM) status is always confidential, to learn more and apply for FARMs <u>click here</u>. Beginning this school year 2022-2023, students who qualify for reduced-price meals will not be charged that cost - meaning that reduced-price students will eat for free! Substitutes Needed for Immediate Hire- MCPS is seeking substitute teachers! Substitute teaching is an excellent way to learn about our schools while allowing principals and teachers to get to know you. To qualify as a substitute teacher, each applicant must present proof of the completion of the minimum of an associate's degree or 60 college credits from an accredited institution. Substitute teachers are temporary employees and are on an on call basis. Substitute Teacher Rates: Daily hourly rate of pay \$18.79- Long Term rate \$26.81. If you hold a valid Maryland professional eligibility certificate or standard advanced professional certificate, the daily hourly rate of pay is \$19.97-Long Term rate \$28.45. Do you have a plan in place in the event that there is an early dismissal? All students should know where to go and what to do if an adult is not home when the child arrives home. Please take time to review your family's plan with your child.

Twinbrook is a Title I School – Information & Details:

If you wish to request certification information about your child's teacher, paraeducator, or long-term substitute teacher, please submit a written request to the principal at your school. Your written inquiry may include information about the following qualifications:

- Degree status and subject area of certification.
- State of Maryland certification status, including conditional certification status.
- Qualifications of paraeducators or long-term substitute teachers who may be working with your student.

Your request will be forwarded to the Office of Human Resources and Development and you will receive a written response from that office within thirty (30) business days. Please contact the principal if you have any questions.

Our school is fortunate to receive supplemental funding through Title I, a federal grant program for schools that serve communities with students who have high economic needs. The federal legislation that establishes Title I regulations is known as, *Every Student Succeeds Act of 2015* (ESSA). ESSA requires Montgomery County Public Schools to inform you that you have the right to request information about the professional certification qualifications of your child's teacher, long-term substitute teacher, or paraeducator (formerly titled instructional assistant).
