

Scholarship Opportunity with Montgomery College

Who:

Current MCPS/CTF students who:

- ◆ Have an interest in Construction Management
- ◆ Are at least 16 years old
- ◆ Have a minimum of 2.5 GPA for seniors/ 2.75 GPA for juniors (unweighted GPA's)
- ◆ Have their own transportation to/from Montgomery College (Rockville Campus) or are willing to use Ride-On bus transportation
- ◆ Classes will take place 12:30 p.m.—2:40 p.m. on Tuesdays and Thursdays at the Rockville Campus of Montgomery College.

What:

The Montgomery County Students Construction Trades Foundation, Inc. will pay the tuition for up to 2 (two) college level Construction Management courses for qualified CTF students. Dual enrollment with MCPS and Montgomery College can assist students in earning an Associate of Applied Science degree.

MCPS students may:

- ◆ Attend home high school and one college class (per semester)
- ◆ Apply for dual enrollment in the Construction Management Program
- ◆ Earn BOTH MCPS 1 ½ high school credits for the Construction Methods and Materials class and also earn 3 Montgomery College credits (*CMGT100, semester one)
- ◆ Earn BOTH MCPS 1 ½ high school credits for the Construction Plan Reading Class and also earn 3 Montgomery College credits (*CMGT110, semester two)

Procedures for Admission and Registration for CTF Students:

- 1) Fill out and submit the “Student Interest Form” (on reverse side) to Kelly Johnson in the Foundations Office (Room 109B).
- 2) Discuss opportunity with family and/or counselor.
- 3) Apply online to Montgomery College (MC) at www.montgomerycollege.edu/dep. **ALL students will receive an acceptance letter to MC; however, it does NOT mean you are officially enrolled/accepted in the Construction Management course.**
- 4) Obtain an unofficial transcript from your home school counselor and turn it into Mrs. Johnson.
- 5) **Sign up with Mrs. Johnson** in the Foundations Office to take the Accuplacer or Accuplacer ESL placement test. **Completion of this testing is not necessary if you have scored:**
 - 480+ SAT Evidence-based Reading/Writing or 26+ on Reading Subtest **OR**
 - 21+ per section of the ACT reading test.

(Please note: You will need to submit **your official SAT or ACT score report** to MC (MC code is 5440) or print your score report in front of an MC representative).
- 5) Be admitted to the CM course (see step 6) **OR** appeal (see step 7).
- 6) **If you are admitted:**
 - Create an account at <https://montgomerycollege.dualenroll.com> to request the MC course. This interactive site will help you request classes and track the approval process. **Approvals** are needed from a **parent/guardian, MCPS, and MC staff before students can official be enrolled in an MC class.**
 - Activate **MyMC** online student account on MC website.
 - Complete the Online Academic Orientation for New Students. Download the certificate at the end and upload it to DualEnroll.com
- 7) **If you appeal (due to GPA and/or Accuplacer scores not meeting requirements):**
 - Mrs. Johnson will schedule interviews for **selected students** with Mario Parcan, Program Coordinator, for the Construction Management program at MC.
 - You meet with Professor Parcan **prior** to obtaining acceptance.
 - **If you are admitted**, follow procedures from Step 6 above.
 - If you are not admitted, please work on improving your reading, skills, writing skills, and/or GPA in order to be admitted for a future semester.
