

BYOD User Agreement

The following expectations are provided to support Blake High School's Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) initiative. BYOD focuses on the use of any handheld or portable device such as a phone or tablet, which a student intends to attach to the Blake network strictly for instructional purposes. Student users should read and accept these expectations.

1. All personal devices connected to the MCPS/Blake network through BYOD are subject to the same policies and procedures established for use of the district owned equipment as outlined in the IGT-RA. Failure to comply with the IGT-RA, applicable laws and/or the BYOD User Agreement will result in disciplinary action.
2. Student use of BYOD must support the instructional activities of the classroom and must be turned off and put away when requested by a staff member.
3. As stated in the IGT-RA, no inappropriate content may be accessed or stored on your device. Users may not post, send, or possess materials that are inappropriate, abusive, obscene, pornographic, threatening, harassing, or damaging to another's reputation or illegal including cyberbullying or "sexting." MCPS/Blake High School will not be held liable for personal content housed on device(s).
4. Users must ask permission before recording an individual or group. Users must obtain permission to publish a photograph or video of any school related activity. Failure to comply will result in disciplinary action.
5. Users may not access the district network with BYOD technology to knowingly alter, damage, or delete district property. Any software on the personal device(s) must not interfere with the normal operation of district owned resources.
- 6. Device Use and Security:** The serial number of your device(s) should be recorded at home. Devices and power cords should be clearly labelled with your name. Students should not expect to use MCPS resources to charge their devices. Mobile device(s) should be brought to school fully charged each day, and devices should be taken home at the end of each day. Students are responsible for keeping device(s) in a secure location when not in use. **MCPS is not responsible for any damage, data loss, physical loss or theft of the device(s).**
7. District technicians will not service, repair or maintain any BYOD technology.
