Application Process

Step 1: The Application

Go to the college website. Determine how to apply and prepare for deadlines.

- **Application Types:** Common App, Coalition App, Electronic/School Specific, or Paper/School Specific Application.
- **Application Deadline Types:** Regular Decision, Early Action (Priority), Restrictive Early Action, and/or Early Decision.

Start working through the application. You will include basic information about yourself, your high school, your classes and extracurricular activities. This is also where you may be asked to complete short answer questions and essay prompts.



Application Process

Step 2: Link Accounts

When applying through Common App, Coalition App or Edocs, you will have to **match** your account(s) to **Naviance**.

Application Process

Step 3: Sign FERPA Waiver

- FERPA is a federal law that protects the privacy of a student's education records.
- In regards to college, a parent must authorize the school to send a student's transcript as this is part of a student's confidential record.
- Submit the [Authorization to Release Records Form](#) to the counseling office and [electronically sign the privacy notice in Naviance](#) waiving your right to see your recommendations.
- It is **HIGHLY** recommended that you check "yes" and waive your right to see/access recommendations.



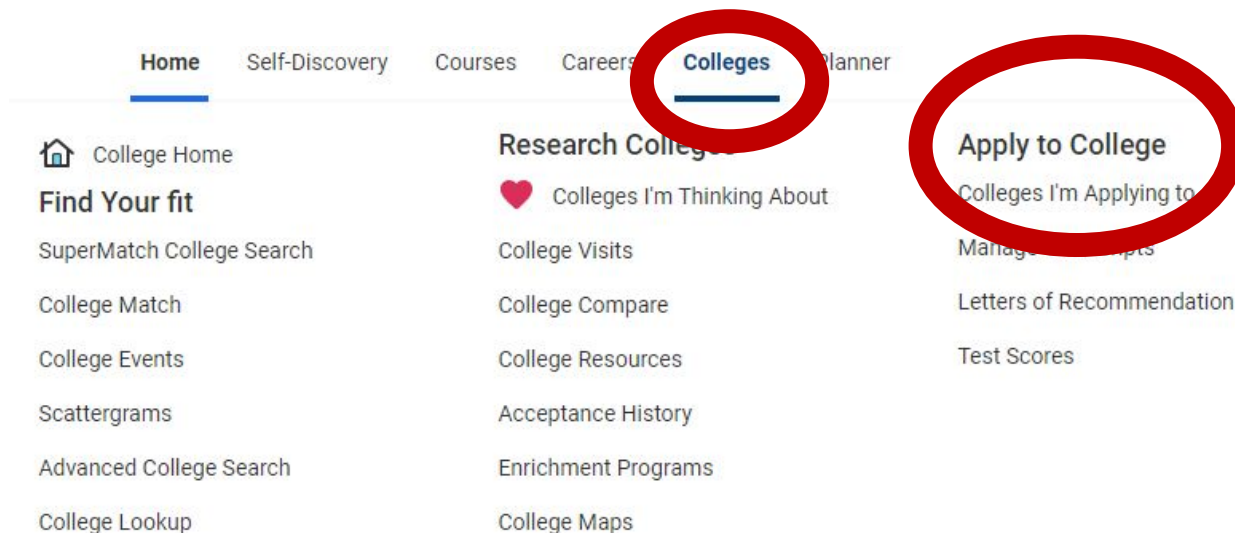

Step 4: Colleges I'm Applying to

When you have finalized your list of schools that you plan to apply to, make sure they are in the “[Colleges I'm Applying To](#)” section in Naviance.

If you are applying to colleges using the Common App platform, once you add colleges to your dashboard and Match accounts, they will automatically appear in Naviance [Colleges I'm Applying To](#)

Once you have done this, you are able to [request teacher recommendation letters](#) through [Naviance](#) (Step 6).

Early Decision Acknowledgement
From the National Association for Admission Counseling Statement of Principles and Good Practices

Early Decision (ED) is the application process in which students make a commitment to a first choice institution where, if admitted, they definitely will enroll. While pursuing admission under an ED plan, students may apply to other institutions but may have only one ED application pending at any time. The institution must notify the applicant of the decision within a reasonable and clearly stated period of time after the ED deadline. Usually, a nonrefundable deposit must be made well in advance of May 1. Institutions with ED plans may restrict students from applying to other early plans. Institutions will clearly articulate their specific policies in their ED agreement.

If you are accepted under an ED plan, you must notify Jackie Carpenter immediately and must promptly withdraw the applications submitted to other colleges and universities and make no additional application.

Please allow recommenders at least 3 weeks to complete your letter.

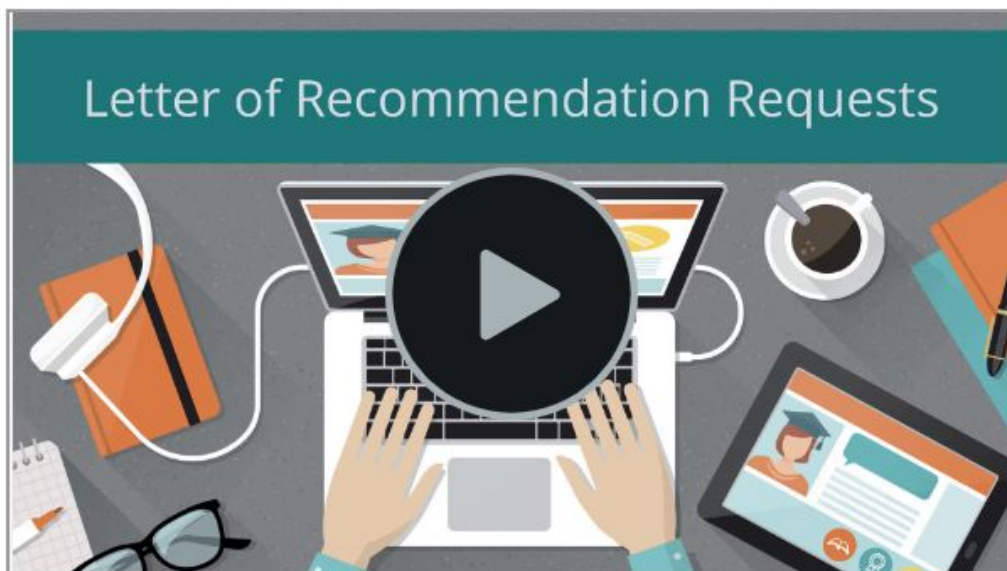
