



### The Basics of Northwest High School







### **Grades & Credits**

- Students take 7 classes each semester.
- Each class is worth ½ credit, and a student must pass the class (with a grade of A, B, C, or D) to receive the credit.
- A student should earn 7 credits *each* year (3.5 credits per semester) if he/she passes all of his/her classes.
- Students must earn at least 22 credits to earn a high school diploma.



### **Grade Point Average (GPA)**

- Students receive a GPA each quarter and semester in addition to a cumulative GPA.
- A student's cumulative GPA is calculated using all high school course grades acquired.
- Students also receive weighted and unweighted GPAs.
- Weighted GPAs include additional GPA points for earning an A, B, or C in honors and AP classes.



### Calculating a Student's GPA

#### Calculating unweighted GPA:

#### For each class:

- •Multiply each A by 4
- •Multiply each B by 3
- •Multiply each C by 2
- •Multiply each D by 1
- •Multiply each E by 0

Divide the sum by the number of classes.

#### Calculating weighted GPA:

For each Honors/AP class:

- Multiply each A by 5
- •Multiply each B by 4
- •Multiply each C by 3
- •Multiply each D by 1
- •Multiply each E by 0

Divide the sum by the number of classes.



### Graduation Requirements: Class of 2027

- 22 Credits
- 75 Student Service Learning (SSL) Hours
- State Assessments: The Maryland Comprehensive Assessment for Algebra 1, English 10, Science Biology and NSL Government will account for 20% of the students final grade in the related course.



### Graduation Requirements

### 22 credits total

- 4 credits of English
- 4 credits of math (including one credit in algebra 1 and one credit in geometry). Students must be enrolled in a math class all 4 years of high school.
- 3 NGSS aligned science courses (including 1 credit of biology, 1 credit of physical science, 1 credit of an earth/space integrated science)



### **Graduation Requirements**

- 3 credits of social studies
  - 1 credit in US History
  - 1 credit in National-State-Local (NSL) Government
  - 1 credit in Modern World History
- 1 credit of fine arts
- 1 credit of physical education
- 1 credit of health education
- 1 credit of technology education



### Graduation Requirements

#### **Program of Study Completers**

- Option 1: Two credits in the same world language or American Sign Language
- Option 2: Four credits in a state-approved career and technology program


