<u>Career Center:</u> Utilize the <u>Career Center</u> and Naviance Student located at https://www.naviance.com/solutions/parents-students
for post high school planning. Ms. Miller, our College and Career Information Coordinator, is available to meet with students and families about the college application process and to help them use Naviance Student, a free online college and career organization program. Parents can request their own Naviance Student account by sending an email to Ms. Miller. Students feel free to stop by the career center before school, during lunch, or after school. <u>Counselors</u>: Your counselor is a great resource to help you get organized, improve your study skills, and create an academic improvement plan to help you achieve your goals. Counselors can be seen without an appointment every day before school, during lunch, or after school. You can also email your counselor to have quick questions answered or to set up an appointment. All counselor email addresses are on the <u>counseling page of the RM website</u>.

<u>English</u>: Students may arrange lunchtime appointments with their English teachers on any day except Thursday. In addition, you may visit the English Composition Assistants in Room 257 for help with writing assignments; later this year, the peer consultants of the Writing Center will also be helpful resources. More information on the Writing Center will be available before the end of the first semester.

EML: Academic Support for EML students is offered Tuesdays in room 264 and Fridays in room 266 during lunch.

<u>Fine Arts:</u> Choral Music, Instrumental Music & Visual Arts/Fine Arts teachers are available during lunch and/or by appointment for their students who seek support in their class.

<u>Homework Club</u>: On Thursdays from 2:40 – 4:15 students can receive academic assistance in the back of the Media Center. Contact Mr. Stillman for more information at: todd e stillman@mcpsmd.org

<u>Library/Media Center:</u> The Library Media Specialist and Media Assistants are available to help you locate books for pleasure reading and with research using books and online databases. We have generified the Fiction section this year, so you can find your favorite book just like in a bookstore! We also have special Banned Books, DELME and Graphic Novels/Manga sections in the library. We have many reference eBooks you can access on your personal devices and MCPS has online encyclopedias, reference books and other resources you can access from home. Just stop by to pick up a sheet of logins and passwords or we will share them in a secure location in google drive. <u>Math:</u> Individual math teachers are available during lunch in their classrooms and specific days after school. Check with your teacher about their availability. The Math Honors Society offers tutoring and homework help during lunch (starting after 1st quarter interims). Room location to be determined. <u>MCPS CARES:</u> Richard Montgomery High School offers free, in-person tutoring to students where we match students with teachers who can provide instructional support in small group settings. <u>Science</u>: Science and Technology teachers are available during lunch and by appointment. See your teacher for their specific office hours. Science tutors are available via the Science National Honors Society – contact Mr. Ashmead in room 341 or by email at rmhs.snhs@gmail.com.

<u>Social Studies:</u> Teachers are available before school, during lunch, and after school. Students can talk to their teacher to find out their availability.

<u>Teacher Email Addresses:</u> Almost all teachers are available to meet with their students before school, during lunch, or after school. Contact your teacher in person or via email to set up a time to meet. All teacher email addresses can be found on the <u>Richard Montgomery HS website</u>.

<u>World Language</u>: World Language teachers are available to provide help during lunch and after school. Please talk to your teacher about their availability.

<u>Tips for Student Success at Richard Montgomery High School</u>

Activity Buses: If you need to stay after school for extra academic help, to attend a club, or to participate in a sport, you can take an "Activity Bus" to get home. There are four buses that run on Tuesdays and Thursdays, leaving Richard Montgomery at 4:35 p.m. Students must show their student ID to get on a bus. These buses do not follow the regular school bus routes. Check the route schedule for the closest drop off near your home. If a student lives within 2 miles of Richard Montgomery and must walk to school, an Activity Bus will not be a viable option for transportation home. The Activity Bus schedule is in the main office and on the Richard Montgomery website.

Check the <u>Richard Montgomery High School Website</u> for such things as the upcoming events calendar, a list of school clubs, summer packets, staff email addresses, counseling resources, and other important information related to school happenings. <u>Counseling:</u> Talk to your counselor or another trusted staff member if you are not feeling good about yourself or are having problems that are keeping you from being successful. You can drop in to see your counselor before school, during lunch, or after school without an appointment or you can ask your teacher for a pass to see your counselor. Or you can set up an appointment to see your counselor by emailing them. All staff email addresses can be found on the <u>Richard Montgomery HS website</u>.

<u>Credit Recovery:</u> If you need to repeat a class, ask your counselor about the Credit Recovery Program. A LIMITED number of classes will be offered. Your counselor will let you know if you are eligible for the program.

<u>Health Room:</u> If you have a health concern, big or small, visit our school nurse, Ms. Azar Javid. Her office is across from the gym and the number is (240) 740-6102. She is knowledgeable about community resources and can connect you with them.

<u>Homework Help 24/7:</u> All MCPS students have access to free tutoring and 24/7 Homework Help to support success in their current courses, through two new approved tutoring providers, FEV Tutor and Tutor Me Education.
