

## 2022 NAACP SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS INFORMATION

The Montgomery County Branch of the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People (NAACP) will award \$1,000 scholarships to students residing in Montgomery County. The scholarships will be presented at the **Annual Freedom Fund Dinner on Sunday, May 15, 2022**, which will be held at Martins Crosswinds, Greenbelt, Maryland. The Freedom Fund Dinner reception starts at 5:00pm and dinner begins promptly at 6:00pm.

### Eligibility Requirements:

- Must be a graduating high school senior
- Must have a grade point average or a weighted grade point average of 3.0 or above
- Must participate in extracurricular activities
- Must participate in faith-based, religious-based, or volunteer activities. If this is not possible because of paid employment, please explain
- Must submit a completed scholarship application *to Ms. Hull in the Career Ctr by March 21, 2022.*

### How to Apply:

- Complete the official application form. The application form may be reproduced but may not be altered and must be filled out completely.
- Submit two school references (original copies on school stationary), including one from a guidance counselor or an administrator.
- Submit the name of your current state Congressional member and/or Delegate (click here to find your representatives - <http://mgaleg.maryland.gov/>)
- Indicate if you will attend a college or university in Maryland.
- Submit a 300-word, double-spaced, typed essay, which addresses the theme, "Don't Rest, the Fight Continues: to Protect our Vote, our Health, our Rights". Students are encouraged to provide their own personal interpretation of the theme. The essay must accompany the application. In addition, a three to four paragraph typed narrative essay about the applicant must be included.
