- **Community Letters vs. Close Contact Letters:** We are now able to administer rapid Covid tests to students who are sent to the health room for displaying symptoms. When a student has a positive result, we are required to notify our community with a general community letter. If your child is identified as a close contact, which is defined as someone who is unvaccinated and was around the student for more than fifteen minutes at less than three feet, the letter will contain the date which your student may return to school and **this date can not change based on a negative test.** If you did not receive the close contact quarantine letter, then your child was determined not to be a close contact and they may attend school as usual.
- **Water Bottles:** Please encourage your child to bring a water bottle to school each day. We do have bottle filling stations in our building, so they are able to refill them.
