- **Rapid Test Kits:** Rapid Test Kits were distributed to MCPS students on Monday, February 14. Rapid tests should be used: When a student has been identified as a close contact to someone who has tested positive for COVID-19—Use a rapid test 5 Days after exposure. When an unvaccinated student is in quarantine—Use a rapid test on Day 5 to return to school on Day 8. When a student has developed COVID-19 symptoms—Use a rapid test at onset of symptoms. When returning from travel or large gatherings—Use a rapid test before returning to school.
- **COVID Reporting:** MCPS created <u>a Google form</u> for reporting your student's COVID-19 test results. We want to be sure families understand the timeline around exposures and positive tests. We have provided a <u>quarantine calculator</u> with all of the dates to help families determine when their child should return to school after testing positive for COVID-19. Again, please use the link above to report if your student tested positive and please use the calculator to determine timelines for your student's return to school.
