## Tip #5 & Tip #6: Student Service Learning (SSL) & Back to School Night

Tip #5: Student Service Learning Hours (SSL): All students must earn a minimum of 75 hours of community service by the end of their high school senior year to graduate from a Maryland high school. Thirty (30) hours are earned throughout the three years of middle school, and these hours are earned during the school year within school hours. 10 hours are earned in each grade, and these hours are automatically entered at the end of each school year. Students earning all 75 hours before graduating middle school will be given the Superintendent's SSL Award. This award may be earned only once in middle school.

MCPS has <u>pre-approved</u> many organizations for SSL. Hours can be earned from these organizations beginning the summer before 6<sup>th</sup> grade. The Montgomery County Volunteer Center website lists volunteer opportunities for people of all ages, not just MCPS students. **Not all the organizations on the website are MCPS pre-approved!** 

- If the organization is <u>preapproved</u> by MCPS, you will see a blue box with

  Once the volunteering is completed, Form 560-51 must be submitted and approved by our Rocky Hill SSL Coordinators. Forms can be found in the Student Assignment Book and on the website <a href="http://www.montgomeryschoolsmd.org/departments/ssl/">http://www.montgomeryschoolsmd.org/departments/ssl/</a>
  - All PTAs and public schools are preapproved for SSL hours and still must follow the SSL quidelines for specific activities.
- If a student wishes to earn hours from an organization NOT preapproved by MCPS for SSL, students <u>must</u> submit the MCPS Form 560-50 Individual SSL Request to their school SSL coordinator at least 2 weeks in advance of the service date for approval. Failure to get pre-approval will result in hours not being accepted. You can find this form in the SAB and on the MCPS website

o All SSL hours must be recorded and verified using form 560-51.

The deadlines set by MCPS for SSL submission are:

- Service completed during the summer: September 23, 2022
- Service completed during the summer and 1st semester: January 6, 2023
- Service completed during the summer, 1<sup>st</sup> semester & 2<sup>nd</sup> semester to be recognized for the Certificate of Meritorious Service (High School Seniors) OR the Superintendent's SSL Award (Middle School): March 30, 2023
- Service completed during the summer, 1st semester & 2nd semester: June 2, 2023

Deadlines are listed at the top of each form and are announced via the morning announcements and the Wildcat Weekly emails. Forms handed in after each deadline will **NOT** be accepted.

Over 1200 forms are handed in over the course of the year at Rocky Hill, so deadlines are important.

- There is a basket in the main office to collect the completed SSL forms.
- Please follow ALL THE DIRECTIONS on the form and be clear. If there is anything
  missing or cannot be read, the form will be returned to the student and that will delay
  entry of the data.
